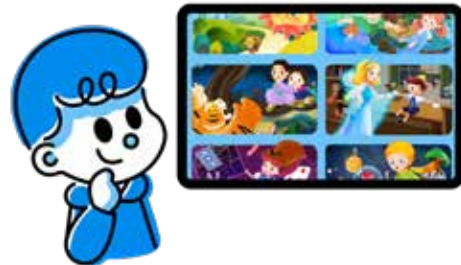


Download and make your own story in StorySelf.
